Judy's philanthropic endeavors are deeply involved with the community. Whether it's healthcare, education, homelessness, synagogue life, or arts and culture, Judy has eagerly volunteered her time and resources to effect change and strengthen the fabric of L.A. Through the Judy and Bernard Briskin Family Foundation, she, and her late husband Bernie, have left a meaningful charitable legacy throughout the city and set the gold standard for community support.

Rex has served on the Board of Directors at Maple Counseling for four years and is currently Co-Vice Chair. Rex's work on behalf of AIDS, Breast Cancer, and Parkinson's has netted over \$1 billion in the past 25 years. He currently works with NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness).

Both magnanimous philanthropists have also been instrumental in realizing Maple's new, state-of-the-art community clinic. Together they have set Maple Counseling on a bright course to take it into the next fifty years of vital community mental health services.

At the same time, Maple Counseling develops the mental health workforce through its structured program for completion of experience required for licensure as a Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), and Psychologist (PhD, PsyD). All services are provided by interns working towards their licensure in the state of California under supervision of highly-experienced licensed clinicians.
